Currently a Visiting Lecturer in Anthropology at NUIM, Robert Moore has been engaged in field research with speakers of an American Indian language, Wasco (Upper Chinookan) since the mid 1980s, with recent work focusing on the aggressive efforts currently underway in the community to document, preserve, and maintain the language through archiving and language pedagogy. He holds a PhD in Anthropology and Linguistics from the University of Chicago, and before coming to Maynooth taught in the Department of Linguistics at the University of Illinois (Urbana-Champaign).
